

ASSISTANT OPERATOR, GRADE II-A (WATER TREATMENT)/ ASSISTANT OPERATOR, GRADE II-A (WATER TREATMENT) (TRAINEE) (OC) RC/EL #25125010

Examination to be held May 17, 2025; Last filing date April 21, 2025

A \$15 non-refundable application filing fee is required. Please refer to Supplement A for further information regarding the application/examination process. Applications are available at: https://mycivilservice.rocklandgov.com/exams.

- 1. If applying online, completed applications and electronic payment must be submitted by 11:59 PM EST on the last filing date.
- 2. If applying by mail, completed applications must be postmarked no later than the last filing date accompanied by a check or money order made payable to the Rockland County Commissioner of Finance.

POSITION EXISTS IN: Village of Nyack Water Board Commissioners.

RESIDENCE REQUIREMENTS: Candidates must be legal residents of the States of New York, New Jersey or Connecticut at the time of application submission for the examination.

SALARY: The starting salary is \$35.44 per hour for a 40-hour workweek with Village of Nyack Water Board Commissioners. Salary will be pro-rated for less than full-time positions.

<u>WHAT THE JOB IS LIKE</u>: This is routine, technical work involving responsibility during the absence of the Chief Operator or while assigned to a specific shift, for the safe and efficient operation and maintenance of any Type A potable water treatment plant. The work is performed under the general supervision of the Chief Operator who has responsible charge of the complete and actual operation of the plant. Work direction may be given to subordinate employees in the performance of their assigned duties. Does related work as required.

When completing the application, your description of experience must specify the dates of your employment, the number of hours worked per week, your title, and the main duties for each. Be specific; vagueness will not be resolved in your favor. Candidates who submit incomplete applications or documentation may be disqualified.

<u>MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS</u>: At the time of application submission, you must have: Possession of a valid Grade II-A or higher (Water Treatment) certificate* issued under the provisions of Subpart 5-4 of the New York State Sanitary Code.

*Certificate qualifications require:

- 1. Graduation from high school or possession of an equivalency diploma, and
- 2. Successful completion of appropriate level water treatment operator courses, and
- 3. One (1) year of acceptable operating experience at a water treatment plant with facilities for filtration.

NOTE: Type A potable water treatment plants have facilities for filtration.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. When required to operate a motor vehicle, possession of a valid driver's license appropriate to the kind and size of vehicle to be driven
- 2. Must maintain the Grade II-A or higher (Water Treatment) certificate throughout the course of employment in this title.

Assistant Operator, Grade II-A (Water Treatment/ (Trainee) – Minimum qualifications set forth above for the primary title, must be obtained through a prior approved trainee program – not to exceed two (2) years.

A single list will be established as a result of this examination. Assistant Operator, Grade II-A (Water Treatment) eligibles will have their names certified for appointment before those eligible for Assistant Operator, Grade II-A (Water Treatment) Trainee. Candidates who are successful and possess the minimum qualifications for Assistant Operator, Grade II-A (Water Treatment) will then be certified for appointment as Assistant Operator, Grade II-A (Water Treatment). Those eligible for Assistant Operator, Grade II-A (Water Treatment) Trainee will be certified at the trainee level. Persons appointed at the trainee level will be advanced to Assistant Operator, Grade II-A (Water Treatment) without further examination upon satisfactory completion of the approved one to two-year traineeship. Candidates originally placed on the eligible list as an Assistant Operator, Grade II-A (Water Treatment) Trainee who acquire the training and experience necessary to meet the minimum qualifications for the Assistant Operator, Grade II-A (Water Treatment) during the life of the list and who submit a new application may then be certified as an Assistant Operator, Grade II-A (Water Treatment).

ALL OUTSTANDING APPLICATION DOCUMENTATION: Must be submitted to the Rockland County Department of Personnel no later than two (2) weeks prior to the exam date. Failure to comply with the deadlines set herein may result in the disapproval of your application; disqualification from sitting for the examination; and/or disqualification from a resulting list of eligible candidates. These deadlines are subject to change by the Rockland County Department of Personnel upon notice to a candidate.

SUBJECT OF WRITTEN EXAMINATION:

- 1. <u>Mechanical Aptitude</u> These questions test your ability to identify and understand how basic mechanical instruments such as motors and gears work.
- 2. <u>Safety Practices</u> These questions test your knowledge of basic safety practices.
- 3. <u>Tools and Reading of Scales and Gauges</u> These questions test your ability to recognize or identify basic tools and their common issues and to make accurate readings of various types of dials, scales and gauges.
- 4. <u>Elementary Chemistry and General Science</u> These questions test your knowledge of basic processes and concepts in chemistry and general science.
- 5. <u>Understanding and Interpreting Written Material</u> These questions test how well you comprehend written material.
- 6. <u>Basic Mathematics</u> These questions test your ability to use addition, subtraction, multiplication and division to solve basic arithmetic problems that might be encountered in water and wastewater treatment plant operations. Questions may also involve the use of fractions, decimals, averages, and percents.
