- 1. If applying online, completed applications and electronic payment must be submitted by 11:59 PM EST on the last filing date.
- 2. If applying by mail, completed applications must be postmarked no later than the last filing date accompanied by a check or money order made payable to the Rockland County Commissioner of Finance.

POSITION EXISTS IN: Rockland County Department of Health.

RESIDENCE REQUIREMENT: Candidates must be legal residents of the States of New York, New Jersey or Connecticut at the time of application submission for the examination.

SALARY: The starting salary is \$105,865 annually for a 40-hour-workweek with the County of Rockland. Salary will be prorated for less than full-time positions.

WHAT THE JOB IS LIKE: This is professional nursing work involving responsibility for coordinating, supervising and participating in the clinical assessment and care planning process of patients in various clinics and programs administered by the Department of Health (e.g. Family Planning Health Services Program, Sexually Transmitted Infections (STI) clinic). The work is performed under the general direction of the Medical Director and in accordance with standing orders and protocol established by a physician. Supervision is provided to professional and technical staff. Does related work as required.

When completing the application, your description of experience must specify the dates of your employment, the number of hours worked per week, your title, and the main duties for each. Be specific; vagueness will not be resolved in your favor. Candidates who submit incomplete applications or documentation may be disqualified.

<u>MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS</u>: At the time of application submission, you must have: A Master's degree or higher in Nursing <u>and</u> two (2) years of experience as a Nurse Practitioner, at least one (1) year of which involved the supervision of other professionals as a major portion of the work.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT:

- 1. Licensure and current registration to practice as a Registered Professional Nurse in New York State must be maintained throughout the course of employment in this title.
- 2. Licensure and current certification as a Nurse Practitioner issued by New York State must be maintained throughout the course of employment in this title.

TRANSCRIPTS:

If using college credits to qualify, official college transcripts must be sent directly from the educational institution to the Rockland County Department of Personnel at reexams@co.rockland.ny.us no later than 10 days after the last filing date; student transcripts are not acceptable. Failure to comply with the deadlines set herein may result in the disapproval of your application and/or disqualification from a resulting list of eligible candidates. Your college degree and/or college credit must have been awarded by a college or university accredited by a regional, national, or specialized agency recognized by the U.S. Department of Education/U.S. Secretary of Education. If your degree and/or college credit was awarded by an educational institution outside the United States and its territories, you must provide independent verification of equivalency. Candidates are responsible for any required evaluation fees. ANTICIPATED ELIGIBILITY - AGE AND EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

According to Civil Service Law, section 54 which became effective September 4, 2024, applicants who are within 12 months of meeting the minimum age or attaining the minimum educational requirements following the date of examination, may take the civil service exam, but will be restricted from certification until such a time that the minimum age or educational requirements are met. Candidates will be required to provide proof of qualifying age and or education within 12 months of exam date in order to be eligible for appointment from a certified list.

<u>ALL OUTSTANDING APPLICATION DOCUMENTATION</u>: Must be submitted to the Rockland County Department of Personnel no later than **10 days after the last filing date**. Failure to comply with the deadlines set herein may result in the disapproval of your application; disqualification from sitting for the examination; and/or disqualification from a resulting list of eligible candidates. SUBJECT OF EXAMINATION: There will be no written or oral test for this examination. Candidates who meet the minimum qualifications will receive a rating based on an evaluation of their training and experience against the background of the duties of the position. You are, therefore, asked to include in your application a summary of all pertinent training and experience in sufficient detail so that your experience may be evaluated against the duties of the position. Your application will be rated on the following items. Make sure your application and supporting documents are thorough to maximize your potential for achieving the highest score.

- 1. Do you meet the minimum qualifications? (See Minimum Qualifications.)
- 2. Do you have two years of experience as a Nurse Practitioner? (Please note starting month/year and ending month/year as well as hours per week worked.)
- 3. Do you have one year of experience which involved the supervision of other professionals as a major portion of the work? (Please note starting month/year and ending month/year as well as hours per week worked.)
- 4. Do you possess a Bachelor's or Master's degree in Nursing? (Official college transcripts must be sent <u>directly</u> from the school to our department no later than ten (10) days after the last filing date.)
- 5. Do you have any continuing education? (Official college transcripts must be sent <u>directly</u> from the school to our department no later than ten (10) days after the last filing date.)
- 6. Do you possess licensure and current certification to practice as a Registered Professional Nurse in New York State? (Please submit a copy of license and current certification with your application)
- 7. Do you possess licensure and current certification to practice as a Nurse Practitioner issued by New York State? (Please submit a copy of license and current certification with your application)
- 8. Do you have any further Nurse Practitioner experience not already listed in #2 above? (Please note starting month/year and ending month/year as well as hours per week worked.)
- 9. Do you have any further supervisory experience not already listed in #3 above? (Please note starting month/year and ending month/year as well as hours per week worked.)
