Examination to be held **November 15, 2025**; Last filing date **October 3, 2025**

- 1. If applying online, completed applications and electronic payment must be submitted by 11:59 PM EST on the last filing date.
- 2. If applying by mail, completed applications must be postmarked no later than the last filing date accompanied by a check or money order made payable to the Rockland County Commissioner of Finance.

PARTICIPATING AGENCY: Rockland County Sheriff's Department.

For this promotion examination, eligibles can be appointed only in the jurisdiction in which they are presently employed.

SALARY: In accordance with the appropriate labor agreement.

<u>WHAT THE JOB IS LIKE</u>: The work involves responsibility for the custody, security and general welfare of incarcerated individuals in the County correctional facility during an assigned shift. The work also involves specific responsibility for guarding incarcerated individuals, enforcing federal, state and local rules and regulations, supervising a variety of incarcerated individual activities, maintaining order and may also involve the physical restraint of incarcerated individuals as needed. Incumbents in this position are sworn Peace Officers as defined in the New York State Criminal Procedure Law. All Correction Sergeants are required to carry a firearm and other necessary equipment (e.g., handcuffs). The work is performed under the general supervision of an officer of higher rank and in accordance with the policies and procedures of the department with latitude for independent judgement. Supervision is exercised over a number of Correction Officers. Does related work as required.

When completing the application, your description of experience must specify the dates of your employment, the number of hours worked per week, your title, and the main duties for each. Be specific; vagueness will not be resolved in your favor. Candidates who submit incomplete applications or documentation may be disqualified.

<u>MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS</u>: You must be currently employed by the **Rockland County Sheriff's Department** and have four (4) years of permanent competitive class status there as a Correction Officer immediately preceding the date of the examination.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Completion of the Commission of Corrections Basic Training Program for Correction Officers and the Commission of Corrections Supervisory Training Course is required prior to permanent appointment.
- 2. Possession of a valid New York State driver's license at the time of appointment and throughout the duration of employment in this title. The appointing authority shall have the responsibility for the verification of the driver's license which may be checked throughout the course of employment in this title.
- 3. **Public Officer Requirements:** In order to be eligible for appointment, candidates must meet all current requirements of Section 3 of the Public Officers Law, including, but not limited to United States citizenship and New York State residency.
- 4. Condition of Employment: Must be legally authorized to possess a firearm throughout the course of employment.

<u>NOTE</u>: If you were permanently appointed to a qualifying title and had provisional or contingent-permanent service in the same title immediately preceding the permanent appointment, such service shall be counted towards meeting the time in title required to apply for this examination.

<u>ALL OUTSTANDING APPLICATION DOCUMENTATION</u>: Must be submitted to the Rockland County Department of Personnel no later than two (2) weeks prior to the exam date. Failure to comply with the deadlines set herein may result in the disapproval of your application; disqualification from sitting for the examination; and/or disqualification from a resulting list of eligible candidates. These deadlines are subject to change by the Rockland County Department of Personnel upon notice to a candidate.

SUBJECT OF WRITTEN EXAMINATION:

- 1. <u>Preparing Written Material</u> These questions test for the ability to present information clearly and accurately, and to organize paragraphs logically and comprehensibly. For some questions, you will be given information in two or three sentences followed by four restatements of the information. You must then choose the best version. For other questions, you will be given paragraphs with their sentences out of order. You must then choose, from four suggestions, the best order for the sentences.
- 2. New York State Minimum Standards for Correctional Facilities These questions test for knowledge of the Minimum Standards for state, county, and local correctional facilities that are promulgated by the New York State Commission of Correction in areas such as the admission/discharge, care, custody, movement, correctional treatment, security, supervision, and discipline of all persons confined in these systems.
- 3. Coordinating Appropriate Responses to Emergencies, Disturbances, and Other Unusual Situations These questions test for knowledge in such areas as: anticipating possible correctional emergency situations, responding to situations promptly and allocating staff where needed; notifying supervisors of situations when appropriate; acting within rules to alleviate problems as quickly as possible with minimum use of force; investigating the causes of incidents; submitting reports on incidents.
- 4. Supervising Incarcerated Individual Correctional Programs, Services, Visitation Areas, and Correctional Staff These questions test for knowledge in such areas as: coordinating programs with civilian staff; ensuring that all employees relate well to visitors and guests and answer their questions in accordance with facility rules; organizing and supervising special programs involving outside groups (e.g., Alcoholics Anonymous, Narcotics Anonymous, etc.) and ensuring full cooperation from employees. The questions may also deal with such areas as: understanding new concepts and developments in the field of Corrections, and evaluating employees' capabilities and limitations on the job.
