1. If applying online, completed applications and electronic payment must be submitted by 11:59 PM EST on the last filing date.
2. If applying by mail, completed applications must be postmarked no later than the last filing date accompanied by a check or money order made payable to the Rockland County Commissioner of Finance.

POSITION EXISTS IN: Rockland BOCES, Clarkstown Central School District and East Ramapo Central School District. Some of the agencies/departments listed above may not have vacancies or be filling their vacancies at this time.

An open-competitive as well as a promotion examination will be given on the same day and qualified candidates may also compete therein by filing a separate application for each. The promotion list will take precedence over the open-competitive list in filling vacancies in the agency listed, but upon its exhaustion, the open-competitive list will be used to fill vacancies occurring for a period of at least one year from the date the list was established.

RESIDENCE REQUIREMENTS: Candidates must be legal residents of the States of New York, New Jersey or Connecticut at the time of application submission for the examination.

SALARY: The starting salary is \$62,883.75 annually for a 40-hour workweek with Clarkstown Central School District. Salary will be pro-rated for less than full-time positions. Salary may vary in other locations.

WHAT THE JOB IS LIKE: This is work responsible for ensuring the safety, efficiency and compliance of school bus routes. This position involves inspecting and evaluating bus routes to ensure they meet all regulatory standards and serve the needs of the students and the school district effectively. The work is performed under the supervision of a transportation supervisor or school administrator. Does related work as required.

When completing the application, your description of experience must specify the dates of your employment, the number of hours worked per week, your title, and the main duties for each. Be specific; vagueness will not be resolved in your favor. Candidates who submit incomplete applications or documentation may be disqualified.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: At the time of application submission, you must have: Graduation from high school or possession of an equivalency diploma and two (2) years of experience driving a school bus with a capacity of twenty-one (21) or more passengers.

NOTE: Possession of a valid driver's license is required at the time of application and must be maintained throughout the course of employment.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

1. At the time of appointment and periodically throughout the course of employment the appointing authority may verify possession of a valid driver's license required for the type of and size of vehicle to be driven.
2. The appointing authority shall have the responsibility for additional driver requirements imposed by:
 - a. Article 19-A, Vehicle and Traffic Law as specified in Part 6 of the Regulations of the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles and
 - b. Section 3624 of the Education Law as specified in Section 156.3 of the Regulations of the Commissioner of Education.
3. If the incumbent possesses current certification as an Examiner (as defined by the Department of Motor Vehicle Law, Section 6.16), the incumbent may be required to conduct state-mandated driver testing. This certification is not to be considered mandatory for the position.

ANTICIPATED ELIGIBILITY - AGE AND EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

According to Civil Service Law, section 54 which became effective September 4, 2024, applicants who are within 12 months of meeting the minimum age or attaining the minimum educational requirements following the date of examination, may take the civil service exam, but will be restricted from certification until such a time that the minimum age or educational requirements are met. Candidates will be required to provide proof of qualifying age and/or education within 12 months of exam date in order to be eligible for appointment from a certified list.

ALL OUTSTANDING APPLICATION DOCUMENTATION: Must be submitted to the Rockland County Department of Personnel no later than two (2) weeks prior to the exam date. Failure to comply with the deadlines set herein may result in the disapproval of your application; disqualification from sitting for the examination; and/or disqualification from a resulting list of eligible candidates. These deadlines are subject to change by the Rockland County Department of Personnel upon notice to a candidate.

SUBJECT OF WRITTEN EXAMINATION:

1. Following Directions (Maps) – These questions test your ability to follow physical/geographic directions using street maps or building maps. You will have to read and understand a set of directions and then use them on a simple map.
2. Bus Driving Practices, Techniques and Traffic Laws – These questions test for knowledge of the principles and practices involved in the proper and safe operation of passenger buses; and the rules and regulations of the New York State Motor Vehicle and Traffic Law governing passenger bus operation, highway safety, and rules of the road.
3. Bus Driver Recordkeeping and Scheduling – A test that requires candidates to work with simple records using general record-book or card-type formats. Questions are based on given records, which usually must be completed by the candidate before the questions can be answered. In order to answer all questions in this subtest correctly, the candidate generally must:
 - a. Follow written directions to understand the purpose and use of the record, and to understand the question;
 - b. Make correct entries in appropriate sections of the record;
 - c. Identify which entries are required to answer the question.A knowledge of bookkeeping, account keeping, or other technical information or technology is not necessary to answer these questions. A knowledge of simple arithmetic functions may be required.
4. Operation of Two-Way Radios including Procedures and Terms – These questions test for knowledge of the principles and practices involved in the operation of a two-way radio and may include such areas as the proper procedures to use when operating a two-way radio, and the standard terminology used when transmitting and receiving messages over a two-way radio system.

USE OF CALCULATORS IS ALLOWED FOR THIS EXAMINATION
