COURIER AND CLEANER

<u>DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:</u> This is a combination of courier and cleaning work. The courier work involves collecting and distributing mail, supplies and other materials. The cleaner work involves applying a variety of cleaning methods to both the interior and exterior of a building. Employees in this class work under supervision, and do not supervise others. Does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

Delivers and collects mail, office and maintenance supplies and other materials;

Operates motor vehicles;

Ensures safety of vehicle for safe operation;

Dusts furniture, blinds, window ledges, etc.;

Collects and disposes of refuse;

Washes windows, floors, walls, tables, toilets and lavatory facilities;

Strips, waxes and sweeps floors/walkways;

Assists in building maintenance work;

May perform routine maintenance on vehicles such as washing, cleaning, changing tires, etc.;

May shovel snow and perform other outside work;

May move furniture, furnishings, and equipment.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:

Working knowledge of the methods used in delivering, distributing, and collecting mail, supplies and materials; working knowledge of cleaning methods, materials and equipment; skill in safe operation of motor vehicles; ability to follow simple oral and written instructions.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: No formal education or experience is required.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT: It is the responsibility of the appointing authority to ensure that the incumbent possesses a valid driver's license.
