

LICENSING AND INSPECTION ASSISTANT II*

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: This is specialized inspection and investigative work in the Office of Consumer Protection primarily involving investigations of home improvement contractors and other businesses (e.g., livery, towing, etc.) to ensure compliance with licensing requirements. The work is performed under the general direction of a higher-level administrator and work guidance (e.g., lead work) may be provided to others. Does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

Conducts applicant and licensee investigations for various licenses, including but not limited to home improvement, livery, towing, etc. issued by the Office of Consumer Protection;

Receives, reviews and investigates consumer complaints by meeting with involved parties, gathering information and making recommendations for the resolution of such complaints;

Conducts independent investigations of suspected violations of local and New York State laws enforced by the Office of Consumer Protection;

Recommends disposition of cases in conformance with laws, regulations and policies;

Maintains records of inspections and investigations and prepares reports and forms;

Performs field work (e.g., inspections at consumers' homes, livery and towing establishments, etc. and routine monitoring and inspection checks for violations of Rockland County local law) to identify unlicensed contractors, resolve problems, respond to complaints, etc.;

Enforces relevant local and New York State laws related to consumer protection by conducting inspections, gathering information and educating consumers and business representatives to identify problems and discuss solutions, etc.;

Conducts research studies aimed at protecting, educating and informing consumers;

Addresses the community and community groups to promote awareness of consumer protection issues;

Provides testimony at administrative hearings;

May develop and disseminate information regarding consumer rights and responsibilities regarding home improvement contractors, licensed or registered businesses that provide direct services to the public, etc.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:

Thorough knowledge of the laws pertaining to home improvement licensing and other local licensing laws enforced by the Office of Consumer Protection; thorough knowledge of investigative techniques; good knowledge of techniques and procedures for gathering facts; good knowledge of the rules of evidence and court procedures; ability to prepare structured reports; ability to communicate effectively, both orally and in writing; ability to understand and interpret consumer protection regulations and policies; ability to establish and maintain cooperative working relationships with others.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Graduation from high school or possession of an equivalency diploma and five (5) years of experience consisting of the following:
 - a. Investigation or inspection duties and responsibilities in the area of consumer protection or in an area affecting the public or a segment thereof (e.g., criminal investigation, social services investigation, building and/or code violation inspections, home or business inspections and/or health inspections); or
 - b. Enforcement of codes, statutes or regulations affecting the public or a segment thereof, including government agencies, private firms or other organizations; or

- c. Providing customer services activities such as resolution of complaints, explanation of services, etc. or the supervision of such activities; or
2. An Associate's degree (or equivalent college credits (minimum of sixty (60) credits) and three (3) years of experience as indicated in 1. above.
3. A Bachelor's degree or higher and one (1) year of experience consisting of any one or a combination of the following as indicated in 1 above.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT: A valid driver's license applicable to the kind and size of vehicle to be driven.

PROMOTION: One (1) year of permanent status as a Licensing and Inspection Assistant I.
