## **RECREATION ASSISTANT**

**DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:** This is largely routine recreation work providing assistance to higher level personnel in the conduct of recreation activities. The work is generally performed under personal supervision of a Recreation Leader but may be performed according to instructions. Does related work as required.

## **TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:**

Assists in the conduct of a variety of sports, games and special events;

Assists with the chaperoning of trips and other group activities;

Assists in the instruction of a variety of sports, games and special activities and participates in same;

Supervises the conduct of children's games and maintains order;

Keeps records regarding attendance, equipment use, activities, etc.;

Distributes and collects equipment;

May officiate athletic contests.

## FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:

Working knowledge of playground activities including several types of sports and games; ability to conduct recreation activities; ability to follow oral and written instructions; ability to maintain simple activity records.

**<u>MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS</u>**: Graduation from high school or possession of an equivalency diploma.

## NOTES:

- 1. Paid experience in the conduct of recreation activities may be substituted for high school on the basis of one (1) season of experience for one (1) year of high school.
- 2. If certification in CPR and/or Advanced Lifesaving are required by the jurisdiction in which the position exists, it is the responsibility of the appointing authority to ensure that candidates are appropriately certified.
